Faculty of Animal Science, Veterinary Science and Fisheries, Rampur, Chitwan is pleased to call for a proposal for research grants for 4 (four) students provided by the Adventist Development & Relief Agency of Nepal (ADRA Nepal) to Masters and PhD students under its standard guidelines and research norms. The following are the further points of elaboration regarding proposal preparation:

- a. The proposal has been called for the **Master's** (MVSc, MSc Ani. Sc.) and **PhD students** who are in their 3^{rd} and 1^{st} to 3^{rd} semester, respectively.
- b. The research should be supervised by the faculty of FAVF. The thesis research of students will be prioritized in granting the research fund.
- c. The proposal must be prepared in any of the following thematic areas-Animal Nutrition (Feed & Forage), Ruminant Production, Mastitis, Animal Health, Infertility and reproductive diseases of cattle and buffalo.
- d. The research must be conducted in **Rupendehi** (Sainamaina Municipality and Kanchan Rural Municipality) and **Kapilbastu** (Budhabhumi and Banganga Municipalities) districts.
- e. The maximum budget (including the taxes) for each proposal is NRs 150,000/- (One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) and there is the possibility of supplement grants for PhD students.
- f. The **50% of the grant** will be provided to students soon after the selection of the proposal and the remaining 50% will be availed after the presentation of findings and submission of the research report to FAVF.
- g. The research work must be completed within the current fiscal year 2080/81. The research report needs to be submitted before 07 Asadh, 2081.
- h. Supervisors are not given any extra remuneration thus budget under such a heading is not acceptable.
- i. The deadline for submission of the research proposal is January 03, 2024 during office hours.

- 2. Introduction (400 words)
- 3. Rational/Justification of the study
- 4. Objectives (may be included at the end of the introduction)
- 5. Materials and methods (500 words maximum)
- 6. Literature reviews (500 words maximum)
- 7. Expected outputs
- 8. Time frame
- 9. Budget
- 10. Limitation of the study
- 11. References
- 12. Annex information including log frame (if relevant)
- 13. Work plans
