Guidelines for final presentation of Internship activities for B. V. Sc. and A. H. 10th semester students

I. Internship Presentation

- a. 8 presentation slots will be formed according to the students roll number, each slot will have 5 students
- b. Each student will get 9 minutes for presenting their internship activities and after completing presentation of a slot, they will pass through the discussion session of 15 minutes, thus completing the slot session in an hour.
- c. For presentation, strictly comply on the following specifications:
- Total number of slides: 12. Discuss your overall internship activities shortly and more specifically focus your presentation on Internship case report.
- Font and font size: regular (minimum font size 24)
- Appropriate photographs for activity glance can be inserted at the end.

II. Internship Case Report

Each student should prepare an Internship Case Report (one most important and interesting case) out of the total cases they attended during their 6 month internship period and should strictly comply on the following specifications while preparing the report:

Font: Times New Roman

- Font size: 12

- Font style: Regular

Font color: Black

- Margin: 1" on top, bottom, right and left

- Spacing: 1.5

Do not exceed 15 pages

- Citations as per APA rule (Follow PG bulletin for detail)

Submission of Internship Case Report (3 copies) during final presentation (duly signed by the major Advisor and the student) is mandatory. The report should be in order of Cover page (with transparency binding), Certificate (signatory page), Table of content and the text. The text of the report should contain the following chapters:

- Summary
- Introduction
- History and Clinical findings
- Diagnosis
- Treatment and Control strategies
- Discussion
- Conclusion
- Key references

Comprehensive Examination on Core Competence in Veterinary skills:

For assessing the core competence in veterinary skills, each student will randomly select one of the 4 areas of Veterinary surgery, Gynecology, medicine and laboratory techniques. One examiner will be appointed for each area who will independently evaluate the students for their clinical skills in that area.
